### **Flibble Family Christmas Pudding Recipe**

1 cup water  
 1 cup of sugar  
 4 large eggs  
 2 cups dried fruit  
 1 teaspoon baking soda  
 1 teaspoon salt  
 1 cup brown sugar  
 lemon juice  
 nuts  
 1 gallon of brandy

Sample the brandy to check for quality. Take a large bowl. Check the brandy again to be sure it is of the highest quality. Pour one level cup and drink. Repeat. Turn on the electric mixer; beat 1 cup butter in a large, fluffy bowl.

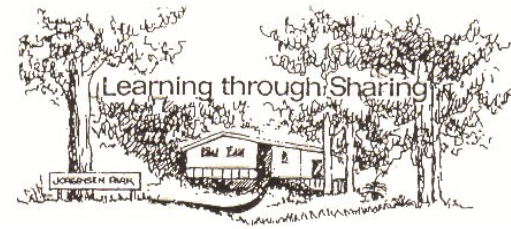
